Episodes are promoted in OpenCV's newsletters and social media feeds which combined reach over 300,000 subscribers.

Guests are expected to prepare a 40-minute presentation on a topic, with slides using software such as Google Slides, Keynote, or PowerPoint.

Episodes air live 9:00am – 10:00am Pacific time Thursdays with guests and hosts joining at 8:45am to ensure audio and video quality as well as quickly review the content of the episode before going live.
