My extensive career has honed my problem-solving skills, often finding solutions that elude others. As a seasoned compositor with several years of on-set supervision, I excel in putting directors and DOPs at ease while also directing support shoots, such as crowd elements. I'm adept at supervising in-house teams and collaborating with directors or VFX supervisors to develop and refine shots.

One of my proudest achievements was working on a complex 5000+ frame split-screen shot for Alien Covenant, where David teaches Walter to play the flute (same actor). This complex scene was attempted and failed by two other companies, prior to me taking up the challenge.

Variety called it the best shot in the film, highlighting its compelling nature and seamless execution with a single actor, praising Scott's unmatched production value.

More recently, I have returned to the world of commercials, recent jobs include spots for Verizon, NY and Peleton, NY. I also managed to deliver an Emirates job, which had been in play since last April. Just before the closure of the Mill I was also involved in the Elvis Immersive experience.
