NOTE: grant funds may NOT be used to pay stipends for faculty time/involvement in the project, or for work that has already been completed. Also, EdPrepLab Research Seed Grant funds do NOT cover institutional indirect costs. Opportunities to share with the EdPrepLab network include, but are not limited to:

- Authoring a brief or series of briefs for the network,
- Presenting about your processes/findings at an EdPrepLab event (e.g., convening, forum, Learning Café, etc.), and/or
- Developing resources to be showcased on the EdPrepLab website (e.g., artifacts, case studies, protocols/tools).

At least one substantive deliverable needs to be completed by the end of the grant funding window. Team members will be appropriately credited for all work highlighted.

We will also announce the award of funding for your project—including its title, focus, members, and aims—on EdPrepLab webpages and member communications. In any future presentations or publications you author stemming from this work, please be sure to acknowledge receipt of an EdPrepLab Research Seed Grant.
