Principal's Pen

Our earthquake drill was productive. We ducked, we covered, we held on, we exited, and we took attendance. Search and Rescue found our "missing" classroom. We practiced our Reunion Gate procedure with a few parents. We brought each classroom their Comfort Kits. Unfortunately only about 5% of students have a personal Comfort Kit. ([Comfort Bag Plan](#)) To alleviate this, teachers will help the remaining students create their own "All About Me" book. In the event of a major disaster it is possible that it will be a little while before your child can be picked up from school. A Comfort Kit with a small stuffed animal, a family picture, a non-perishable snack and anything else you think would help your child and still fit in a one-gallon zip bag. If you are going to make a comfort kit please bring it to the classroom so the teacher can ensure that it makes it safely into the earthquake bin we have on campus.

During a major disaster your child will not be released unless checked out by a parent or someone authorized by the parent on the Emergency Card. To have your child released to your care, go to the "Request Gate" near the play structure. The members of the Request Gate Team are responsible for greeting parents, guardians, or designees and providing them with tags or other identifications authorizing the holders to reunite with their students at the Reunion Gate. Once you have your tag, walk to the "Reunion Gate". The members of the Reunion Gate Team are responsible for sending a runner to bring your child to you. Your child will remain with his or her teacher, or with another staff member until you or a designated representative arrives. After 72 hours other civil authorities will provide additional care for unclaimed children and MES will likely become a disaster relief center. ([Reunification Map](#)) ([On-site Assembly Map](#)) Note: **Children will only be released to a person listed on the current Emergency Card.** That person will have to show valid identification to the teacher, and sign a release form which our school will retain for recording purposes.

On Friday our Superintendent sent us this important message: [Dangers of Fentanyl - One Pill Can Kill](#). It has information that may save lives. With Halloween approaching I want to remind parents of the decades-old concern of tainted candy. Parents should caution children from accepting candy from strangers. I recently read this news release from LADPH about Fentanyl laced pills and candies. Together we can keep our young children safe.

Halloween brings other considerations for parents too. Here are tips for staying safe while trick o' treating: Always walk on the sidewalk, never wear a mask that restricts your vision, decorate your costume with reflective tape or stickers to make yourself visible, carry a flashlight, stay in familiar neighborhoods, stay in groups of three or more, never enter a stranger's house, and have a parent inspect candy before a child eats it. Finally we look forward to our annual parade. Parents may watch and cheer on campus. As always, no weapons or discriminatory, sexist, or hateful costumes are allowed.
