Celebrate Victories

- Every Lowell race is contested. There were even enough qualifying candidates to require preliminaries in several districts.
- State Rep. Vanna Howard co-sponsored 24 of 26 bills in Progressive Mass agenda.
- Gov. Baker signed bill creating State Hate Crimes Task Force.
- Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court established the right of trans, queer, lesbian, gay, and bisexual people to not be discriminated against in jury service.
- State Department will allow nonbinary and intersex people to obtain IDs and passports with an “X” gender marker instead of an “M” or and “F.”
- Ur Mendoza Jaddou, the daughter of Mexican and Iraqi immigrants, became the first woman director of United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).
- Native American conservationist Charles Sams named to head of National Park Service.

350MA just completed white paper on Heat Islands, working with city to renew community aggregation.

Win Flint appointed to Lowell Sustainability Committee. It has been focused on solar energy for high school and recycling.
