Available Position: Part-Time Reading Specialist

The reading specialist, under the direction of the school administrators, will work with 3rd – 6th grade classroom and EC teachers to assess students’ reading abilities, develop plans and provide evidence-based instruction to support students who need reading and writing intervention.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Assessing the reading and writing/spelling skills of students for the purpose of screening, program placement, development of intervention plans, instruction and progress monitoring.
- Providing targeted evidence-based reading instruction in small groups or one-on-one for students who are not yet meeting English Language Arts standards and grade-level reading benchmarks.
- Designing and implementing intervention lessons based on the science of reading, including supporting phonological and phonemic awareness, phonics and word recognition, fluency, vocabulary, content knowledge development, and comprehension.
- Monitoring student progress regularly and adjusting instruction based on data and student responses.
- Maintaining accurate records of student progress, attendance, and intervention outcomes.
- Collaborating with classroom teachers, special education staff, and support teams to align interventions with core instruction.
- Participating in grade level meetings, MTSS meetings, and problem-solving teams as needed.
- Co-planning and co-teaching with Grade 3-5 ELA teachers to conduct whole group and/or small group literacy and language arts instruction.

- Providing regular progress reports to parents, teachers and administrators.
- Performing other duties as assigned by Administrators.

Qualifications and Skills:

- Valid NC teaching license in Reading
- Experience teaching elementary ELA and reading intervention lessons
- Strong knowledge of evidence-based reading instruction practices
- Experience administering reading diagnostic assessments
- Strong oral and written communication skills
- Effective interpersonal skills
