Fall 2025 PlayMetrics Registration Process

The first thing to understand is what age group your player(s) will be in Fall 2025. Everything is done by birth year for the Recreation program. See below for the Fall 2025/Spring 2026 Age Matrix:


- The Greenville Recreation program offers three practice location preferences for families to choose from: MeSA Soccer Complex (1020 Anderson Ridge Rd., Greer, SC 29651), Wenwood Soccer Complex (1967 Ridge Rd., Greenville, SC 29607), and the Brushy Creek Soccer Complex (4524 Old Spartanburg Rd., Taylors, SC 29687). Please note this when choosing the team you want for your player.
 - Each age group will be presented a list of program options to choose in the
 registration menu. For example, U6 might have 7 different options based on the teams
 we had in Fall 2024. A choice might say "CESA Carter U6 MeSA Mon/Wed 5:30pm"
 and players can select the team they'd like to be on based on the coach, location, and
 schedule presented.



Every package will be listed with Coach Name, Location, Practice Days, and Practice
Time. Even if a coach chooses NOT to return for Fall 2025, we want players to be
able to sign up to be with their previous teammates so, in most cases, we will use the
Fall 2024 Coach's Name as the identifier. There will be a waiver agreement in the
application that the Head Coach is subject to change prior to the Team Assignments
being posted.



- If there's a replacement already planned to take your team, we will reflect that in the registration options where we would then list the Spring 2025 coach AND the Fall 2024 coach. For example, CESA U6 Atkins (Carter) MeSA Mon/Wed 5:30pm.
- From April 18-May 12, returning players will still have priority to get back on their Spring 2025 team. Each team will be capped at a certain number--this will depend on the age group--and then no one else will be able to register for that specific team after that roster max is reached.
- Please note that new or non-returnings players will still be able to sign up for returning teams during this early registration period. However, if a returning player tries to register before May 12 and see their team is full we will remove a new player to make room for them. Please note, that CESA will not move a new player to a different team without communicating first. There will be waiver agreement attached that all non-returning players must agree to:



 With that said, it's REALLY important your returning players sign up during this early registration period because on May 12 anyone can sign up to be on your team if spots remain. I will not remove new players to make room for returning players who forgot to sign up early.

- If a returning player tries to register for their Spring 2025 team prior to May 12 and sees the team is full and can't register, they need to pick any available team in their age group and register for that team. After doing so, email Cole Atkins (atkins.cole@gmail.com) so he can manually move your player to their Spring 2025 team. IF YOU DO NOT EMAIL COLE TO MOVE YOUR PLAYER WE WILL NOT DO SO. There are 2,000 players in our program so it's important you communicate with us so we know to move your player to their Spring 2025 team.
- Teams that do not currently have a coach when registration opens will be listed with a "TBA" in the team name. If you register your son or daughter for one of these teams and you're interested in becoming the coach please indicate that later in the registration form. The following statement will also be included in any "TBA" team registration:



- For any players that want to join a new team and have friends that want to be on that same team, families will need to communicate with one another to register for the same team. We are giving families the ability to make their choice of what they want during the registration process.
- Lastly, Recreation players that choose to tryout for the Junior Academy or Travel programs during our May Tryouts should still sign up for Fall Recreation in the event they don't make a team or choose to stay in Rec. This is important because once a team fills up we will not remove players who've already been placed to make room for these players. If your player makes a competitive team we will use your recreation registration monies and apply it to your competitive dues.
