Believe in Yourself!



This is your child's Weekly Smile Folder. It will be sent home **EVERY FRIDAY**. It is used as a communication folder to see how your child's week went at school.

One of the most important aspects of your child's first experience in a school setting is learning appropriate behavior. We will be spending a great amount of time in this area throughout the year.

We have one classroom rule, which is the Golden Rule:

**TREAT OTHERS THE WAY YOU WANT TO BE TREATED.**

In addition, we have three standards for behavior:

- Make good decisions
- Solve problems
- Show respect

These three important standards and Golden Rule are to be followed at all times.

We use a color code system to keep track of our behavior and it is communicated daily on a Behavior Record (the document that

looks like a calendar in the Weekly Smile Folder). This Behavior Record needs to be returned EVERY MONDAY! It is so important that you reinforce your child's great behavior at home. Every child has the right to learn in a positive environment free of disruptions. We work very hard in Rm. 9 to make this happen. The students will never be asked to "move their magnet" (change color) for something that they have not been taught a procedure for and practiced several times. Every student also gets at least one verbal warning before they are asked to move their magnet to another color. The color codes are as follows:

- **GREEN:** Great Day!
- **YELLOW:** Warning
- **BLUE:** Lose 1 recess
- **PURPLE:** Lose 2 recesses (Call Home)
- **RED:** Talk to Mr. Ruiz (Principal)/Mrs. Kocher (VP)

We are striving for all green days everyday!

**Rewards:** Great behavior deserves to be rewarded! I have many daily incentive/rewards programs going on in the classroom. Students who have an all green Behavior Record at the end of the week will get to choose a prize from the prize box. Students who complete their work, and who follow the Golden Rule and 3 standards for behavior will have the opportunity to participate in Fun Friday.

\*\*\*These last weeks of August we will simply be practicing the procedures of using our Behavior Record. Our first prize box drawing will be the first week of September. You will find your child's first official Behavior Record (calendar) in their backpack this Friday.
