

What is a subscription database?

A database is like a virtual library. It is a searchable collection of regularly updated reference articles, encyclopedia and dictionary entries, magazine and newspaper articles, excerpts from books, book reviews, eBooks, primary sources and images. Citations are always included. And, it is all available online. When you search one of these databases, you are not searching the Web; you're searching pre-selected material that is the equivalent of what you might find on a library shelf in print.

Why should we use them?

- ☐ Unlike most information published on the Internet, much information found through searching databases:
 - ☐ Comes from originally published print resources
 - ☐ Has been evaluated by professionals for reliability
