



2018 Barbera Dragon Vineyard

Fresh aromatics of daffodil intertwine with hints of leather and flavors of dark fruit creating a beautiful balance with the significant tannin structure of this wine. A faint mesquite flavor is evident, and blends beautifully with the overall flavors. The dark red color from the intense grape skin provides a backdrop to the high retained acidity of this grape transplanted from Italy to a remote region of California. Late to ripen in the coastal-influenced continental climate of the valley, this wine beautifully expresses the uniqueness of Humboldt County climate and soil.
