**Ongoing Deadline:**

**Title:** Computers for Learning (CFL)

**Funding Source:** U.S. General Services Administration

**Funding Amount:** In-kind awards of computers and computer equipment

**Description:** Schools and educational organizations are eligible to request computer equipment reallocated from government agencies. Applicants must register with the CFL website. Once registered, schools can view and select computer equipment that federal agencies have reported as excess and submit requests for items they need. Items include: laptops, desktop systems, monitors, servers, keyboards, scanners, printers, and keyboards. Note: the school must pay shipping and handling.

**Title:** Shade Structure Program Grant

**Funding Source:** American Academy of Dermatology (AAD)

**Funding Amount:** Up to \$8000

**Description:** Grants to preschools, childcare centers, and public schools serving children for projects that increase the safety of outdoor play spaces. Funding may be used for the cost of materials and installation of shade structures. Applicants must demonstrate that they have an active sun-safety/skin cancer awareness program for at least one year prior to application and must be recommended by an AAD member dermatologist. Grantees will also receive a permanent sign to be placed near the shade structure featuring sun-safety tips. Examples of outdoor locations that are eligible for grant funds can include, but are not limited to playgrounds, pool decks, and eating areas.

**March 2023 Deadline:**

**Title:** After-Prom and Graduation Grant

**Funding Source:** Herren Project

**Funding Amount:** \$500 - \$2,000

**Description:** Grants of up to \$2,000 to USA high schools and preparatory schools to support safe and substance-free school events. Funding is intended to cover the expenses of school-hosted events that encourage healthy choices and substance-free celebration activities after graduation or prom.
