Before the objective, Authors should provide an adequate background, and theoretical frameworks which are used in order to discuss the problems as the objective of the research to show which is the best of previous researches, to show the main limitation of the previous researches, to show what do you hope to achieve (to solve the limitation), and to show the scientific merit or novelties of the paper. Avoid a detailed literature survey or a summary of the results.

The article should be between 10-11 pages (not more than 5000 words), single spaced, 11 point Times New Roman font, excluding references and appendices. Use no indent for

the first paragraphs and do not leave a space between paragraphs.

The following paragraphs is indented first line 1cm.

readers will find it difficult to judge the work.

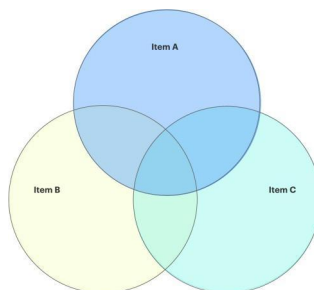
