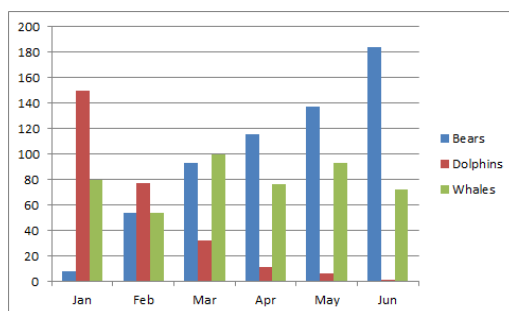


Figure 1: Title should be placed below the figure (TNR, 10, Single Spacing, Centre Aligned)
