Hello MHS Students & Families,

Excitement is building for the MHS Prom Event on Saturday evening (May 4). The event will take place at the Rustic Dreams Barn & Venue in Lyman from 7:00-10:00 pm. In order to facilitate a safe and enjoyable event please review the following information:

1. **ATTENDANCE at SCHOOL:** Students must be in attendance at school on Friday, May 3 to attend the event.
2. **STUDENT CONDUCT:** Students must be in good standing (behaviorally) to attend the event.
3. **PARKING:** On-site parking is available, however carpooling and drop-off is highly encouraged.
4. **ENTRY to the EVENT:** Entry to the event begins at 6:30 pm and closes at 8:30 pm sharp. Any students arriving after 8:30 pm will not be admitted and refunds will not be issued for students who missed the 8:30 pm deadline.
5. **STUDENT SEARCHES & ASSESSMENT:** Students will be searched, observed, and assessed upon arrival to ensure illegal substances and weapons do not enter the facility, and to ensure students are not under the influence of illegal substances. Law enforcement will be on hand to assist.
6. **STUDENT IDENTIFICATION:** Students must bring identification and their prom ticket to be admitted to the event - (School ID, Drivers License, Maine State ID, passport, or other official governmental identification card that includes your name and picture). This applies to all guests of MHS students as well. Entry to the event is dependent upon some form of student identification referenced above.
7. **PROM THEME:** This year's event theme is 'Once Upon a Prom' (in the spirit of the movie *Tangled*).
8. **REFRESHMENTS:** Snacks are provided (not a full meal) - students are encouraged to eat before/after.
9. **LEAVING THE EVENT:** Students will not be permitted to come and go from their vehicles. When students leave the event they will not be admitted reentry to the venue, and they are expected to leave the property. Loitering in the parking areas after leaving the venue will not be permitted.
