Job Description

The Utah Schools for the Deaf and the Blind (USDB) invites you to consider an enjoyable and gratifying employment opportunity with our school. We are looking for a caring and motivated individual to fill the Educator for the Deaf/Hard-of-Hearing position for secondary students at the Kenneth Burdett School of the Deaf in Ogden, UT.

Roles and Responsibilities

As an Educator, you will:

- Provide appropriate programming for deaf/hard-of-hearing students
- Develop lesson plans that incorporate the Utah State Core Curriculum, adapt the curriculum to meet individual student needs, and use effective teaching techniques to translate lesson plans into productive student learning experiences.
- Teach secondary classes, including reading, writing, technology, or other assigned classes, using the course of study adopted by the Board of Education and correlated with other appropriate learning activities.
- Establish and maintain a standard of student behavior needed to achieve a functional learning environment.
- Understand and use computers and other technological classroom support equipment in student instruction.
- Understanding of hearing technology and troubleshooting

Minimum Requirements

The ideal candidate will possess or be eligible for:

- Minimum of a Bachelor's degree in Deaf Education (Master's degree preferred)
- American Sign Language skills are required with an ASLPI rating of 3+ or better.
- State of Utah Deaf Education License or State of Utah Special Education Teaching License with Deaf/HH endorsement
- Successful completion of a criminal background check
- Preference will be given to deaf/hard-of-hearing individuals.

Compensation

Salary based on Teacher Salary Schedule, commensurate with education and experience. These positions are eligible for a full benefits package, including medical, dental, and life insurance; long-term disability insurance; a retirement plan; personal and sick leave; and other valuable benefits.
