Principal's Report – Roger Arbabi

- Lacrosse Teams Play both teams playing today and have had a great season. Boys especially just had a great finish in a game last week.
- Construction Update Still planning to be in by Aug with much of the building material
 inside installed. Things are moving at a fast pace. We'll be five classrooms short so we'll
 have five teachers floating without permanent
- **Docudrama Tomorrow** Powerful presentation by PTSO for seniors to help dissuade any students from drinking
- Senior Last Week Last day May 31, Grades lock on Monday, June 3rd, Computers turned in June 4th
- AP Testing Complete by Friday May, 17th. A record number of exams have been taken this year. 2100 up 50% since Mr. Arbabi 1300. This is incredible on top of the number of concurrent enrollment classes our students are also taking. Concurrent enrollment has doubled in the same time. We've had numerous Utah state academic representatives come to tour the school to understand how these programs are working and progressing. Mr. Arbabi is very proud.
- **Teacher Appreciation Week** Thank you from the Principal for everything done last week. Heather asked if the PTSO should change the week for 2025 because of everything else going on at the same time. Mr. Arbabi felt that the timing was Okay and it didn't need to change.
- Cell Phone Policy Study Mr. Arbabi has been working with committees to consider
 what changes should be made to the school cell phone policy. They're contemplating
 what should be done to see if banning them would be harmful or helpful. They've have
 been some discussions about using pouches where students would put their phones
 during class.
- Book Challenges/Review Kite Runner, Handmaid's Tale, and one other book were challenged this year but because they weren't actively being used in any class curriculum the school declined to review it.

• **Graduation Balloon Photo Opportunity** - PTSO is doing a 2024 graduation balloon photo display on Dozer field 2-3 days before graduation where seniors can have their photo taken with family and friends.
