


The Iron Trial By Holly Black & Cassandra Clare


Magyk By Angie Sage


Falling Kingdoms By Morgan Rhodes

The three kingdoms of Mytica are on the brink of war, and four key players, a princess, a rebel, a sorceress, and an heir find their fates intertwined.




Poison By Bridget Zinn


Fablehaven By Brandon Mull


The Burning Sky By Sherry Thomas

A young elemental mage named laolanthe Seabourne discovers her shocking power and destiny when she is thrown together with a deposed prince to lead a rebellion against a tyrant.






Hawksong By Amelia **Atwater-Rhodes**


Gregor The Overlander By Suzanne Collins


Dragon's Bait By Vivian Vande Velde


The Magician's Nephew By C.S. Lewis


Magonia By Maria Headley


The Hobbit By J.R.R. Tolkien


The Fire Within By Chris D'Lacey


The Story of Owen By E.K. Johnston
