Executive Order No. 3

Subject: Erecting Statues of Great Men

Whereas, Senator Robert Francis Kennedy took special interest in Appalachia, touring the region and writing a book on the people, culture and potential of the area.

Whereas, Robert Kennedy was tragically killed June 6th, 1968.

Whereas, Such a great man who saw the potential of Appalachia should be remembered.

Whereas, President Lyndon Baines Johnson used the office of the Presidency to pass a number of bills which positively affected Appalachia, such as the Appalachian Regional Development Act.

Whereas, A man with such a positive effect on Greater Appalachia should be remembered.

Therefore, I, Goog Mann, Governor of Greater Appalachia, hereby order the following:

Section 1: Constructing Statues of Great Men

1. Statues of Senator Robert Francis Kennedy and President Lyndon Baines Johnson shall be erected and placed at the entrance of the State Legislature Building.

Section 2: Creation of Days of Celebration

- 1. August 27th, the date of President Lyndon Baines Johnson's birth, shall henceforth be known and celebrated as LBJ Day.
- 2. November 20th, the date of Senator Robert Kennedy's birth, shall henceforth be known and celebrated as Robert Kennedy Day.

Section 3. Enactment

- (a) I direct the Lieutenant Governor to take the steps necessary and proper to ensure the publication of this Order in the Regulatory Notice Register and the dissemination of the publication to all State agencies.
- (b) This Order takes effect immediately upon publication in the Regulatory Notice Register.
