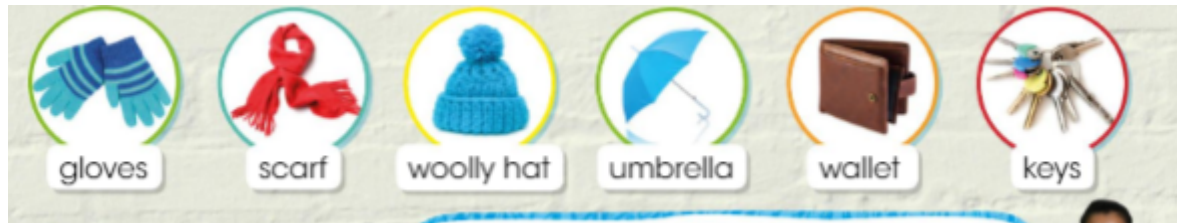

TRANSPORT FOR LONDON

LOST PROPERTY OFFICE

People leave lots of things on public transport in London. What happens if you leave your gloves on a bus, your scarf on a train, or your woolly hat in a taxi? It goes to the Transport for London Lost Property Office, on Baker Street.

They put coloured labels on the lost property. There's a red label for an item you leave in a taxi, a white label for an item you leave on a bus, and a yellow label for an item you leave on a train. Information goes onto a computer system. If somebody contacts the office, they use the computer system to find the lost property. Lost property stays at the office for three months. After three months, the items go to charity.

DO YOU KNOW?

At Christmas, they give lost teddy bears to children who don't have Christmas presents.

FUN FACT!

The home of the famous detective, Sherlock Holmes, is also on Baker Street. The name of the Lost Property Office computer system is SHERLOCK!

WOW!

People lose strange things, too. Look! False teeth, a gorilla costume, and even a life size Spider-Man!

Can you guess what people lose most? Mobile phones, wallets, umbrellas and keys. There are more than 10,000 umbrellas!
