- **Thursday December 5: Concert in Robbinsdale** – Church is instating a cap of 43 wind musicians (plus percussion) for performing in the main sanctuary space, as we are just too big for all musicians to fit safely. Board discussed how we can either A) ask if there is a larger space at the church, we can perform such as a dining hall/event space, or B) make the concert optional, and have sections ask for volunteers to play vs not play so as to keep under the designated cap. VP Tony also pointed out band members can still come to the concert and enjoy it as an audience member and get the fun and cool experience of hearing the full band from the audience perspective which is often different from how the band sounds at their usual section seat within the band.
- **Monday December 9: Concert at Galilee Church, Roseville** near Rice St and McCarron's Bar/Brill and Lake.
- **Monday December 16: Concert at Central Baptist Church, Minneapolis** – St. Paul (correction), near the MN United Soccer Stadium and I94/Snelling
- **City forms** – Pres. Amanda now has access to City of Roseville Parks & Rec forms. Need to submit them days ahead of time to P&R staff have enough lead time for any requests and bureaucratic processes.
- **Key** – Maintenance Facility Key needs at least 3 Business days' notice with form submitted for access, P&R Pickup Truck needs at least 5 Business days' notice with form submitted for borrowing the vehicle.

- **Folder Shortage** - Cathy (Librarian) says we are short on band folders with new band members joining, and she has been unable to access library storage space for new folders until get a hold of Dan who has the key. Please turn in extra folders as soon as possible for redistribution to new band members.
 - Many more red folders are needed for new members. Each section will report the number of new folders needed to President Amanada who will organize getting new folders from the band storage garage.
 - Ample missing red band folders that have never been returned by former members. Unsure where to find them to send a formal letter on Roseville City Letterhead. If President Amanda can get a list of former members names and last known addresses with outstanding folders to Secretary Joseph, he can do some investigating and try and track down updated addresses for official Roseville Letterhead notices to be sent via US Postal Service physical-mail.
- **New music**-Dan has list and will buy as he sees fit – Purchased and handed out Star Trek classic TV shows medley (TOS > VOY), Dragoons of Villars. Dan can also put together a list of missing

conductor scores the band should get, either purchase or borrow/scan from another community band, send list to President Amanda.

- Band members found hand out of music but need to turn back in for scanning then get again confusing; request going forward that music is only handed out AFTER being fully scanned.
- Ideally, hand out music to section leaders, then they can make copies hand out to their sections the next week when the music will be first played.
- Please put new music in the Choir Room chairs for more efficient disbursement of music, music is not forgotten, and music is not put on top of percussion instruments.
- New band members request that when Dan stops the band mid-piece that he gives a full arm cut-off, rather than just stopping conducting.
- River boat trip was fun and went well. No alumni joined, however 1/3rd the emailed invites bounced back, plus the short notice given. 16 band members went on the cruise this year, compared to 26 last year. That may be due to the longer lead time last year, shorter notice this year. Recommend giving greater notice (2 months or more) so band members (and potentially alumni) can more likely attend.
