The databases offer quality information on most subjects and in every format. Some can also filter according to reading level.

[EdPuzzle](#) is a fantastic tool to help flip your classroom. You can narrate over a video and insert stopping points to ask comprehension questions. You'll know if students have watched the video and how many times they needed to re-watch a section. It integrates seamlessly with Google Classroom. Reach out if you need assistance getting started.
