TEAM FOCUS ON IMPROVING ATHLETES/GROUPS

- Lead coaches, Barbara (Bronze), Kate (Silver), Kerry (Gold), and me (Senior) agree on the following areas of focus for advancing swimmers, and practices will reflect this plan.
 - Body Alignment in the water, including streamlining off of turns and starts. Body alignment during swimming (long axis = freestyle and backstroke) and short axis (breaststroke and butterfly).

- Stroke Technique - varying by the group- but learning proper mechanics and using drills that will also be used by swimmers as they advance from group to group.
- Proper timing of breath during swimming.
- Fast kicking.
- As appropriate, aerobic and anaerobic development sets.
- Non-swimming things - Character development, Goal Setting, Being a Good Teammate...
