All students in senior Kindergarten through Grade 2 have completed Early Reading Screening. Results will be communicated to families in the coming weeks. Our primary teachers will use this data to support reading instruction in the classroom.

The Canadian Cognitive Abilities Test has been administered to grade 4 students. Individual results have been shared with families.

2024 individual EQAO data has been received and shared with families. School-based data is summarized below, with the percentage of students who achieved at or above provincial standard in each grade and area indicated.
