Our Curriculum for Young 5's

We believe children learn best through play. The classroom time is structured for a varied amount of whole and small group learning activities. We have circle time, and free choice center time where the child may choose a variety of activities consisting of Literacy, Mathematics, Science, Technology, Health and Safety, Social Studies, Sensory, Creative Expression and the arts. The curriculum also includes other gross/fine motor skills. We are a Christian preschool. We believe Bible stories that tell of God's love, mercy, and forgiveness are important. We have weekly Chapel Time and daily devotions. We promote Kindergarten readiness by helping children problem solve in social situations such as sharing, resolving conflicts, and developing self-help skills.

The Young 5 class was developed to bridge the gap between the preschool year and the full day, 5 day per week Kindergarten program. Social and academic focuses are the main component of the Young 5 curriculum. With two additional days STEM, Science, Social Studies and greater cooperative learning are infused with the strong PreK curriculum to create an all-around secure foundation to start their formal school career.
