Congregation Membership Agreement

pledges to support the mission of Pennsylvania Interfaith Power and Light through the following commitments

- **Formation:** We commit ourselves to incorporating environmental celebrations, challenges, and concerns into our times of collective gathering throughout the year. *These actions may include: prayers, liturgies, reflections, & special services.*
- Education: We commit ourselves to learning about ourselves, our state and country, and global community in regard to a changing climate and its intersections. These actions might include: displaying education materials in key locations, hosting child or adult education focused on understanding climate change and its intersection with our faith tradition, & including information on this issue in communication channels.
- Advocacy: We commit ourselves to supporting efforts in advocating for local, state and national policies that address climate change and environmental justice. *These actions may look like: sharing PA IPL action alerts with your congregation, participating in local opportunities for climate action, & collecting petition signatures or comments.*
- Conservation: We commit ourselves to stewarding our resources (land, buildings, budgets, communities) with environmental best practices in mind. *These actions may include: conducting an energy audit, reducing carbon footprint, planting native trees & pollinators, establishing food gardens, and purchasing renewable energy.*

We understand that Pennsylvania Interfaith Power & Light offers itself as a resource to us for each of the commitments referenced above. We commit to regular communication and ongoing participation in the work of PA IPL through yearly financial contributions, sharing communications and programs, and sending 2 voting members to each year's Annual Conference. We commit to fostering a spirit of inclusion and interfaith collaboration. We offer these commitments as a statement of our intentions, and with understanding that our context and capacity may vary season by season.
