

GOVERNOR OF THE ATLANTIC COMMONWEALTH

Executive Order 9: Governor's Commission on Police Accountability

Whereas, police officers are the backbone of our communities; and

Whereas, they are charged with protecting our communities; and

Whereas, when there are bad actors within our policing institutions our communities are put at risk; and

Whereas, the people of the Atlantic Commonwealth deserve safe communities protected by accountable police officers.

Therefore, I, Pacman A. Crossley, Governor of Atlantic, hereby order the following:

Section I: Creation of the Governor's Commission on Police Accountability

- 1. The Governor's Commission on Police Accountability is hereby established to advise the Governor of the Atlantic Commonwealth on issues relating to bad practices of police departments throughout the Atlantic Commonwealth and outlining practical solutions on the state level.
- 2. The Commission shall be composed of three members for each of the three congressional districts of the Atlantic Commonwealth.
 - a. One member from each district shall be a law enforcement officer;
 - b. One member shall be a law enforcement administrator; and
 - c. One member shall be a citizen who specializes in police accountability.
- 3. The Speaker of the Assembly and Minority Leader shall also serve as *ex officio* members of the commission.

Section II: Responsibilities of the Governor's Commission on Police Accountability

1. The Commission shall hold hearings with relevant public safety experts to advise the Governor on specific executive and legislative actions which could reasonably be accomplished to promote accountability in community policing.

- 2. The Commission shall publish a report considering policing methods and tactics which should and should not be used by police forces across the Atlantic Commonwealth and the report shall be disseminated to the various localities for their own benefit.
- 3. The Commission shall advise the three Secretary's of the Commonwealth's three districts to enact such policies as would be beneficial to proper policing within our communities.
