

# FMHS Theatre General Meeting Minutes, 10-9-18

## President- Cathy McIntosh (Liv's mom)

- Welcome, introductions, call to order- Meeting called to order at 7:04 pm
- Approval of last month's minutes, verifier of tonight's minutes- Leann Coward verified last months minutes. Shane Summers motioned to approved them and minutes were approved unanimously. Jenny Risberg will verify the minutes for tonight.
- Volunteer of the month presentation- We asked for volunteer recognition from the committee chairs. April McGhee's name was drawn as the winner of two free theatre tickets to a show of her choice. Thank you, April, for helping out with ticket sales for Peter and the Star Catcher!
- ITS- students who owe dues/convention/or auction money.- ITS money is due by October 31. We are collecting for two things. The first is the balance for the convention in November. Most paid a deposit of \$100 at the end of last year and have a remaining balance of \$75. The second thing we are collecting for is ITS donations. Current members only need to pay \$25 OR donate \$25 worth of items to the ITS auction. Debbie emailed statements to students who have a balance. If we didn't have an email for them in our database, the statement was emailed to Mr. Valentine. Please check with your student or you can ask Debbie tonight following the meeting what you still owe if you are unsure.
- If you ordered a department shirt, they are available for pick up this evening after the meeting.
- The district is looking for parents to be a part of Engage which is a series of 3 meetings (October 24, March 20/25, and April 25- childcare provided) to learn more about the LISD. If you are interested, let Cathy know.
- The theatre field trip is October 25 after school. Some kids will need to ride with the parents who are attending so we don't have to have two buses for a small number on the second bus. Dinner will be provided by the Booster Club.



## Vice President of Fundraising- Lori Williams (Abby's mom)

- SnapRaise- ends Oct. 31. We currently have 72% participation with \$8945 raised. We need to reach 77% participation to receive the most money possible. Please post on your social media and encourage your students to do the same.
- Drama Daze- Nov. 3.- We have over 30 kids signed up thus far. Please share this event with friends, neighbors, etc. The registration form can be found on the theatre website.
- Tamale orders- begin on Nov. 1 and will be due by Nov. 12 (new date).- We need someone with a pickup truck or larger vehicle to pick up the tamales during the day sometime during the week of December 3. (There was a volunteer who was going to speak to Lori after the meeting)

We should be back to the school about 10:00 or so. The cast list for Mamma Mia is out and the mandatory parent meeting will be Wednesday, October 24 in the auditorium.
