

# MR. MANNES'S ALGEBRA II CLASS

## SYLLABUS

Book: Algebra II by Larson, Boswell, Kanold and Stiff

I. Required Materials: All students are required to bring their textbook, a spiral notebook, folder, a pen, a pencil and graphing calculator to class EVERY DAY.

II. Classroom Rules: There are three basic rules in this classroom, in addition to the rules in the student handbook. I expect each student to know and abide by the following:

1. BE ON TIME (each student is expected to be in his/her desk when the bell rings)
2. BE RESPONSIBLE (complete assignments on time, come in for extra help when needed, take notes and stay on task)
3. BE RESPECTFUL (to others people and their property)

III. GROUP WORK: In almost any job today, people are required to work in a group or on a committee. Group and partner work is also very helpful to math students. Every student is expected to actively participate in any group situation. We will be doing this about every day. Unless you are not using your time wisely then I will take group work away for a certain amount of time.

IV. CHEATING: Cheating is not allowed. If you are caught cheating then I will follow the cheating policy that is in your student handbook.

V. NOTEBOOKS: Each student is required to have a spiral notebook and a folder. Everyone is required to take notes in class. You will have notebook quizzes one a quarter so it is a good idea to take good notes

VI. MAKEUP WORK: According to the student handbook, you have two days for the first day absent, with one for each additional day absent to make up the work. You are responsible for getting the assignment when you are absent, as well as for getting the work handed in on time. I WILL TRY AND REMIND YOU!! It is your responsibility to get the assignment, notes, bell ringers, ect., from Mr. Mannes when you return to class. There may also be instances when students are required to be absent form school for some reason pertaining to school, such as field trips, ect. Each student is required to get the assignment and to have the work completed prior to these types of absences. Failure to follow any of these guidelines relating to absences will result in a zero.

VII. ASSIGNMENTS: Everyone is expected to do the assignment on time. IF you for some reason, you do not hand your work in the day it is due, you may take a late grade.

Late assignment will follow the late assignment section in your student handbook three zero in one quarter will result in a detention.

VIII. GRADING SCALE: Will follow the grading scale that is in your student handbook. Grades will be based on daily work, quizzes and test. Quizzes and test are weight more than daily work. The rule here is that one point a test is worth 3 points on and test and 2 points on a quiz.
