Below, you will find a list of the courses you will take in the fall 2021 semester.

FALL 2021 COURSES

DES 230 Industrial Design II (4 credits) CRNs: 36033, 36034

DES 240 Visualization I (4 credits) CRNs: 36035, 36036

DES 500 Preliminary Year Combined Studio (4 credits) CRNs: 38571 and 38572

DES 520 Graduate Seminar/Elective (4 credits) CRNs: 44133 and 44134

The School of Design will offer two sections of this course in the fall semester. I have attached a description of one section to this email and will send out the other when it is available later in the summer. You may also take a 520 course offered by the [School of Art+Art History](#) or the School of Architecture if you prefer. I will send out any additional information I get about classes in those areas as well.

At least for this first semester, it is my recommendation that you choose a 520 course offered by the School of Design but if you find something else that is preferable, we can discuss with your Director of Graduate Studies, Felicia Ferrone.

When 2 CRNs are listed, You need to register for both numbers as one corresponds to a lecture and the other for a lab for the same course. One CRN will be 4 credits and the other will be 0, but you must be registered for both.
