Excellency:

I would first and foremost like to congratulate you on your new position as the Governor General of Canada, and the representative of the Crown here in our nation on behalf of my party. You have had a long history of experience on Parliament Hill, and I hope that you will be able to use that experience to make informed decisions in your new position.

I write to you today to request that you utilize your Reserve Powers to call the Houses of Parliament to gather once more, so that the Government may face the House to determine whether they still hold the confidence of the House.

Responsible government is the basis of our parliamentary system, and the Government's avoidance to use the tools that the House of Commons requires to maintain basic functionality is egregious. The Reform Party of Canada recognizes that you, during your time as Prime Minister, has rendered advice to prorogue, but the House must continue sitting until the decision has been communicated, of which it has not been. Most MPs still sit in their offices, waiting for a confirmation of whether the rumors floating around the nation are true, and so the House must still conduct business.

I am fully aware of what this request entails, and so I do not make this request lightly. I am cognizant of the fact that the Summoning of Parliament is typically done on the advice of the Prime Minister. However, with the position now vacant, and complete lack of communication from the Government, I humbly request that Your Excellency consider Summoning Parliament so that the Government may finally face the nation.

I stand, just as ever, in full respect of Your Excellency's judgement on this matter regarding the use of the reserve powers, and I will be available for further decision at your earliest convenience, should you wish.
