Summer School Rules and Regulations

Summer school will begin May 27th and run through June 12th, 2025. The morning session will start at 8:00am and end at 12:00pm. The afternoon session will begin at 12:30pm and end at 4:30pm.

ATTENDANCE

Each day of Summer School is roughly equivalent to a week's worth of coursework during the regular school year. Therefore, daily attendance is required. Any student who misses more than **1 day** will NOT receive credit for that semester course. **Please do not ask for special consideration.**

EXAM DAYS

ALL STUDENTS MUST BE IN ATTENDANCE ON THE LAST DAY OF EACH SEMESTER TO TAKE THE FINAL EXAM. Students will not be permitted to take the final exam early. Students should be aware that an absence from class on exam day may result in a failing grade for the course. There will be no final exam exemptions in Summer School. All students, regardless of course, grade in school and letter grade in the class, will be required to take the final exam.

TARDINESS

All students are to be in their classrooms when the period begins at 8 am for the first session and 12:30 pm for the second session. Any student who arrives after 8:00 am or 12:30 pm but before 8:15 am or 12:45 pm will be marked tardy. Three accumulated tardies are to be treated as an absence. A student who continues to show up tardy thereafter may be dropped from class at the discretion of the Summer School administration.

STUDYING

Summer School courses cover a great deal of material in a short time; consequently, students must study both during and outside of the school day.

GRADES

Students who are taking courses for credit will receive the same type of grades as given during the regular school year.

LEAVING THE BUILDING

Students are not to leave the school building unless they are leaving school grounds for the day, or getting lunch between morning and afternoon sessions. **Students must notify administration**

before leaving the building. We encourage families to send lunch with their child to support students staying on campus between sessions. **Walsenburg Jr. Sr. High School does not take responsibility for students that leave the building for lunch.** Students will be required to sign in/out for attendance purposes.

DRIVING

Any student who drives to school must observe all driving regulations and all safety regulations. Permission to drive a car to school may be revoked at any time in the interest of safety and attendance.

DISCIPLINE POLICIES

All disciplinary policies will apply as outlined in the Walsenburg Jr/Sr High School Student Handbook. Copies will be available in the Summer School office if requested.

SPECIAL SERVICES

Students requiring accommodations due to an IEP or 504 Plan should contact Avlisa Preciado (apreciado@huerfano.k12.co.us) prior to enrolling in Summer School.

CELL PHONE POLICY

There are to be no cell phones (unless teacher permits) in the room. If classroom cell phone expectations are not followed, disciplinary action will take place per the Student Handbook.

ONLINE EDGENUITY CREDIT REDEMPTION CLASS

High School students complete a computer-based program. Students will have to work in the class during the credit redemption time allotted. **IF THE STUDENT DOES NOT PASS THE CLASS THEY WILL BE FINED A \$25 COST OF THE CLASS.**

Junior High students will be participating in activities to prepare them for the next grade level and support them with areas that were challenging for them during the school year.

LUNCH

Students will need to bring their own lunch. Students will be allowed to leave campus between 12:00pm - 12:30pm for lunch with permission from their guardian. Walsenburg Jr. Sr. High School is not responsible for students who leave campus for lunch. **Students will need to be back on campus on time, and ready to learn if they are attending an afternoon session class.**

This form must be returned and signed by parent and student in order to be eligible.
