

# Cell Phone Photography & Editing Apps All Ages

## **Description:**

You can take great pictures with your cell phone but did you know there are some great tricks to get even better pictures? You can do more than just use a filter! We will learn some basic rules of photography as well as use free Adobe Lightroom to make some creative edits.

### **Learning Goal:**

By the end of this workshop, students will be able to apply 3 composition rules of photography to get better pictures. They will also learn how to use Adobe Lightroom CC on their phone/tablet to edit their pictures in black and white, preset filters, and individual color selections.

## **Step-by-Step Instructions:**

- 1. Please go to the composition website and watch the video on composition rules. We are going to focus on the first 3 rules.
- 2. Go take some pictures using the first three rules
  - a. Rule of Thirds
  - b. Leading Lines
  - c. Diagonals
- 3. Watch the Lightroom tutorial.
- 4. Install the Adobe Creative Cloud app to your smartphone or tablet, or try the free trial on your laptop or PC.
- 5. Start editing your photos!
- 6. \*If you get stuck or need a little help, do a Google search for "Lightroom for mobile tutorials."
