Proposal Context:

Why Southeast Asia?

According to The [2022](#) and [2023](#) Global Crypto Adoption Index by Chainalysis, many Southeast Asia countries including **Vietnam, Philippines, Thailand**, are among the top 10 performers in cryptocurrency in the world. This indicates a significant and growing interest among individual investors in these nations.

Interestingly, Singapore and Philippines are the leaders in Southeast Asian [crypto 2023](#) based on per capita basis (43,5% & 40,3% respectively) and following with other countries Malaysia, Thailand, Vietnam and Indonesia in total 14,7%. This makes sense because Singapore and Philippines are already the Asia Crypto Capital, not just users, developers but also in economy. Citizens here are applying blockchain-based technologies in their business heavily, bringing the adoption rate based on the country sizes bigger.

According to [Consensys's 2021 report](#), Southeast Asia has four countries in the top 10 of Metamask's Monthly Active Users including Philippines, Vietnam, Indonesia, and Thailand.

Given the positive trends in the Southeast Asia crypto market and the supportive regulatory landscape in key countries, we propose the establishment of an initiative focused on:

- **Market Expansion:** Capitalizing on the growing interest among individual & institutional investors in the Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, and Indonesia.
- **User Education:** Conducting awareness & networking events, sponsorship to attract users and developers on a regional level.
- **Developer engagement:** Build a solid from low-to-high level engineers communities in this region to contribute to the Polkadot ecosystem **as a new generation**.

This initiative aims to position our organization as a key player in the Southeast Asian crypto market, leveraging the region's economic potential and the evolving regulatory landscape.

Regulatory Landscape:

THAILAND (source: [Freemanlaw](#))

- Positive regulatory movements for the crypto industry.
- Cryptocurrencies are considered "digital assets" under specific regulations since May 2018.
- Thai SEC regulates digital asset businesses, lifting trading restrictions in 2014.
- Licensing required for fund managers and advisors from Feb 24, 2021.
- Income from digital asset trading is taxed at 15%.
- Bank of Thailand aims to regulate stablecoins and develop a Retail Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC).
- Stricter identity verification for large transactions since late 2021.

VIETNAM (source: [Kyros Ventures](#))

- Cryptocurrencies not recognized as legal tender.
- No specific cryptocurrency taxes due to this non-recognition.
- Exclusion of peer-to-peer lending and virtual asset service providers from new anti-money laundering regulations.

- Increased interest in Bitcoin due to instability of Vietnamese Dong.

PHILIPPINES (source: [Fintechnews](#))

- Embraces cryptocurrency due to a tech-savvy population.
- Cautious regulatory framework by the government.
- BSP regulates virtual currencies; SEC oversees securities.
- Capital gains tax of up to 15% implemented; more taxes discussed for 2024.
- Regulations focus on transparency, user protection, and adoption.

INDONESIA (Source: [Sumsu](#))

- Established entities for legal clarity and user protection.
- Added 501 cryptocurrencies to promote adoption.
- Crypto oversight transitioned to OJK by January 2025, potentially classifying cryptocurrencies as securities.
- Various regulated crypto business types with specific requirements.
- Mandatory AML measures, Travel Rule for transactions above USD 1,000, and penalties for non-compliance.
- ICOs are not yet regulated; further regulatory changes anticipated.

Problem Statement:

In the dynamic landscape of the Southeast Asia cryptocurrency market, the adoption of Polkadot faces a critical challenge. Despite the region's increasing interest in digital assets, the awareness and utilization of the Polkadot ecosystem remain surprisingly low. With just a fraction of the crypto community actively engaged in Polkadot-related platforms, the untapped potential is evident.

The Southeast Asian crypto market holds immense opportunities for Polkadot, yet its adoption is hindered by a lack of localized efforts in building a strong users & developers base. The absence of comprehensive materials in local languages and limited outreach



initiatives restricts the platform's visibility, preventing it from gaining traction among both end-users and skilled developers in the region.

This situation demands immediate attention. The urgent need to bridge the awareness gap is pivotal to establishing a substantial presence in this rapidly evolving market. A strategic and well-executed marketing and communication campaign is essential to enlighten and captivate the Southeast Asian crypto community, fostering an understanding of the transformative capabilities of Polkadot.

Failure to address this challenge poses a risk of missing out on a wave of innovation and growth in the Southeast Asian crypto landscape. It is imperative to seize this moment and unlock the full potential of Polkadot in this thriving market. By spearheading targeted initiatives, we can propel Polkadot into the forefront of Southeast Asia's crypto adoption, ensuring its success in an environment ripe for technological advancements.

Solutions:

The Polkadot SEA is a team of diverse agents in the ecosystem with *the mission of fostering unrestricted access and development within the Southeast Asia region* - the [Next Wave of Growth for Crypto](#) industry. The proposal intends to form a collective entity comprising active contributors from the Polkadot SEA region. These contributors have varied strengths and involvement within the Polkadot ecosystem. The goal is to assemble a strategic team focused on exploring this market to bring tangible value to the Polkadot ecosystem. This value includes aspects such as fostering local developers and builders, establishing institutional partnerships, and shaping community narratives.

Motivation of the Proposal - The motivation behind this proposal stems from a visionary commitment to propel the growth of Southeast Asia and, in turn, elevate the Polkadot ecosystem within the Southeast Asian countries, stemming from the following reasons:

- *Milestone-Driven Growth CaseStudies:* This initiative aims to achieve specific milestones, foster a loyal and thriving crypto community across all categories, and establish robust partnerships within the ecosystem. Two notable case studies are [Superteam](#) (currently supporting Solana), and [Regional Hubs](#) (currently supporting NEAR)
- *Untapped Potential:* Entities associated with the Polkadot ecosystem have yet to fully leverage resources and show dedicated attention to the SEA community. This region boasts a high adoption rate, as evidenced by numerous reports, making it a top priority for building a user and hardcore developer community platform. Many other blockchain projects are also vying for a presence in this industry. As Polkadot is getting into [Gaming strategically with Unity](#), plus the importance of [Web 3.0 games industry in SEA](#), this entity raises significant benefits for Polkadot in general in 2024 to fulfill the developers interest and end users funnel.
- *Abundant Resources:* The SEA region, as a whole, possesses abundant resources, and crypto regulations in many countries are favorably inclined, offering opportunities for economic development. This environment presents significant prospects for numerous organizations seeking to establish a thriving financial industry.

Through this proposal, we aspire to lay the groundwork for sustainable growth, foster inclusive participation, and position Polkadot as a catalyst for technological progress in one of the world's most promising and dynamic regions.

Developer Bootcamp + Mini Hackathon

5. Connect teams with contributors within the ecosystem to establish a smooth operational process.

We will allocate funding for advisors in terms of traveling expenses and small tips to ensure they are well-motivated to bring good insights and value for Polkadot SEA. Typically, advisors do not receive a salary but view this opportunity as mutually



beneficial, aiding in the expansion of their personal branding and network. This approach ensures positive advancement in all aspects.

We keep the identity of 3 advisors confidential for now according to their request. But the advisors will happily have a call to verify with any important parties to make sure they are legit.

- Merchandise: We will manage to produce 400+ T-shirts with Polkadot SEA version and give it for special cases (side events, partners visit, etc)
