Connect Five On A Multiplication Chart

Materials: Multiplication Chart
1-10 Spinner
Crayons or Map Pencils

1. Each player chooses a different color of crayon or marker.
2. The first player uses a pencil and a paper clip to spin the spinner two times.
3. The first player multiplies the two numbers.
4. The first player finds the product on the chart and colors it with their color.
5. The second player takes a turn, coloring the product on the chart. If the product has already been colored, you lose your turn.
6. The first person to color 5 squares in a row wins the round.
