Who We Are-

Kindred is a small, community based, parent-led, diverse group that believes in the beauty of homeschooling in the way that is best for each family. When-

Every Thursday, 12-14 weeks in the Fall and in the Spring. Arrival time is 9:45am and cleanup is finished by 1:45pm. You can stay and play/socialize until 2:30pm if desired.

Where-

We meet at a location in Jacksonville.

How Does It Work?-

This is a co-op. This means we are all hands on deck. Parents must stay in the building the entire time and help by teaching a class, assisting, helping clean/set-up, or other duties as needed. Parents may volunteer to teach/assist a class or they will be assigned a spot based on need. We try to offer multiple class options each semester for school aged children (based on interest, number of kids, etc) plus time to socialize and make friends. We try to keep costs low by everyone contributing to supplies for the classes their child/ren are in. Some (rarely) classes may have a small supply fee instead and will be noted before the beginning of the semester. We do the majority of our communicating and planning through a private BAND group. Once accepted, you will be added to the group and will need to be active there to participate.

Cost-

Cost is \$50 per family each semester, a small fee for our host location, plus the cost of your background check once every 2 years. Fees go directly to co-op supplies, party day supplies, special activities and other co-op needs.
