- -Incubated MIFSI: Montana Indigenous Food Sovereignty Initiative led by MSU Tribal Lands Dept.
- -Distributed in Hot Springs Vegetable Box program.
- -Set up Hot Springs free vegetables using Food Stamps
- -On-Line Farmers Market (working to reestablish);
- -Developing a Statewide Network of Food HUB's
- -Mobile Food Truck (Kids Co-op Nutrition Kitchen)
- -Food Sovereignty (<u>SKC game</u>; CSKT <u>Info.</u>/Farms; and Squash Growing-Processing-Marketing Project w/ CSKT)
- -MSU partnerships with Indigenous Food Video's & the production and marketing of value added food products.

- -One Small Town program (launching in 2024 in Ronan)




- -Little House Co-op: Multiple Partner Types
