

French Café Morning Themed Activity Pack

Some ideas to celebrate all things French. Suggestions aimed at all learners so please pick and mix & adapt accordingly.

Learn - watch the [BBC Bitesize lesson](#) to learn a bit about France & see how much you can remember. Draw a poster / create a fact file / prepare a short presentation.

Be creative - make a 2D or 3D picture of the Eiffel Tower (or another famous landmark) using straws, ice lolly sticks, lego, play dough or cocktail sticks and grapes! [Click here for 10 different ideas!](#) Use your artwork to decorate your café or as a placemat on the table if it's a picture.

Listen - enjoy the traditional sounds of a [French café](#) with this music. Why not set a café up at home?

Perform - choose a French song you have learnt this year, [learn one now](#) or make up your own one on a specific topic to a tune you know. Practise it, make up some actions & perform it as entertainment at your café. Why not record yourself to hear how you sound speaking French?

Write (in English or French) - create a simple [menu](#) for a café for [food](#) and/or [drinks](#). Watch some [videos](#) by Mr Innes to learn more words for food. Include the costs for each item using pounds or euros (or both & try using an [online convertor](#) to work this out).

Research - Ask family / friends or use the Internet to find out what food or drinks are typically served in cafés in France. See if you can find any of these items (and anything else French) at your local supermarket and have this at your café (biscuits, croissants etc). Have a tasting session and see what you like most - can you say this in French?

Make - read a recipe in English for [French toast](#), [crêpes](#) or [crêque monsieur](#) and have a go at making them (or something else easy from your café menu). Why not try making a video of yourself preparing your dish, like [this example?](#) Or work out how much it costs to make each item? Price it to make a profit & work out how much!

Decorate & relax - create some bunting using the [French flag](#) or [write about yourself](#) or make some wall art with an acrostic poem about [France](#). Don't forget to include lots of pictures.

Café time - sit back & enjoy some French food & drinks. Why not act this out with a waiter and a customer! See some useful vocabulary here.
