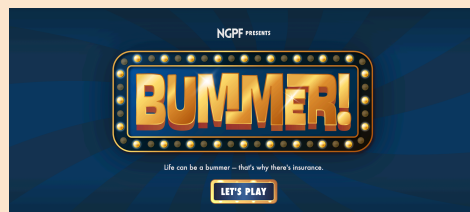

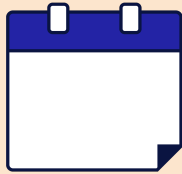


Addressing Common Student Misconceptions
