



Equipment for Presentations:

All UCET presentation rooms will have a screen and an LCD projector available for your presentation. The LCD projector will have an HDMI connection. If you need a different connection, you will need to bring a converter/adaptor with you.

If you are using a Mac laptop, an iPad, or a tablet, you must bring your own adapter to connect to the projector. Be sure to bring the appropriate HDMI connection adapter for your device to plug into the projectors. Because there are so many different types, our volunteer Tech Support staff will not be able to provide adapters.

Projecting iPads or other devices - We can't guarantee that the below listed devices or programs will work on the wireless network. It is advised that you plan to **not have** this capability and be ready to present without them. Screenshots or videos may be a good alternative. Another option is to have the appropriate adapter so that the device can be directly connected to the projector.

- Apple TV
- Chromecast
- Reflector app
- Airserver program
- Splashtop apps

Sound

Each room will use the HDMI cable to carry sound to the projector or house speakers. Bring speakers with you if you would like a backup plan.

Power

There will be power provided in each room to the table or presentation area. If you have multiple devices that need power, consider bringing an extension cord/power strip as a backup.

Ethernet/Wireless

Each room at UVCC will have an ethernet connection. If needed, please bring your adapters to use the ethernet connection. This is the recommended connection to the internet. Ethernet cables will be provided for you. Wireless networks will be available.
