Attention Third Grade Families:

In the coming months, we will be starting our recorder curriculum in 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade and we are very excited to do so! If your child already owns a recorder, you do not need to purchase one. If you are purchasing one, please fill out the following form: Recorder Order Form

If you wish to purchase one on your own, please go by this make and model. <u>Yamaha Soprano Recorder</u>. However, please be aware that you may not receive a neck strap, cleaning products, or joint grease with this purchase on your own.

We play recorders in elementary school for the following reasons and goals:

- 1. to enforce music literacy
- 2. to prepare students for ensemble playing
- 3. to introduce musicianship and musical habits
- **4.** to embrace responsibility and accountability
- 5. to demonstrate proper instrumental playing techniques

All children in 3rd, 4th and 5th grade will need a recorder to participate in music class. The recorders cost \$8.00, and with that purchase, you will receive a brand new recorder, a case, cleaning tools, and a neck strap. They will be YOUR recorders, and the students will be able to take them home as they please. If you are unable to purchase a recorder at this time, please contact us. We have alternate solutions.
