6:00 – Parent and Traveller Meeting

1. Save on Foods cards – Sam will explain this fundraiser

3. Passports - who are still waiting on theirs? Make sure all passports are valid up until Oct 23, 2023.
4. Passports -you must go on your EF account and submit your passport information onto this EF site

6. This is from EF - All travellers, including myself and the chaperones need to confirm their passport details and their name to EF no later than 110 DPD. There is flexibility with regards to the passport details, but names at a minimum must be confirmed no later than December 18th.
