- ★ Answer the question/address the task of the prompt with a thesis statement

- ★ State the main idea/claim in a topic sentence
- ★ Elaborate on your idea/claim
- ★ Give direct and/or indirect evidence from the text to support your answer

- ★ State the main idea/claim in a topic sentence
- ★ Elaborate on your idea/claim

- ★ Wrap-up/transition sentence



Paragraph #4

- ★ Conclude your response by summing up your main ideas
 - o Main idea from paragraph 2
 - Main idea from paragraph 3
- ★ Leave your reader with a final thought
 - Make a connection to a greater truth
