Our district is excited to partner with Florida's free literacy program for families: New Worlds Reading. This program, administered by the University of Florida Lastinger Center, is designed to support students who are not yet reading on grade level. Eligible families in VPK through 5th grade will receive nine free books delivered to their home, along with helpful reading resources. Parents can register at newworldsreading.com. These books are aligned with the Florida B.E.S.T. Standards and come with activity guides that support the science of reading. Families can choose books in English, Spanish, Haitian Creole, or braille, ensuring accessibility for all readers. All titles are carefully selected in collaboration with the Florida Department of Education.

As a reminder, there is no supervision for children before 7:15am. The school buildings are closed and students must wait outside. It is very unsafe.

We continue to have many Dress Code Violations. Clothing may not have any rips in them and no spaghetti straps are allowed. All shirts must cover the tummy area completely. All shoes must be <u>closed</u> toe and closed heel. The district does not permit students to wear Crocs in elementary school.
