

## Transfer Guide for:

## Clark College

George Fox University Bachelor of Science in Education –  
Elementary Education Track

**Note:** Clark College is on a quarter system, while George Fox is on a semester system. **Any credit taken at Clark will be worth 2/3 credit at George Fox.** Remember to take this into consideration when figuring out how many credits will transfer from Clark.

**Transfer Overview:** A maximum of **135 quarter** or **90 semester** hours will be accepted from community colleges.

- Only coursework with a grade of “C-” or better will be accepted.
- Courses must be 100-level or higher
- One quarter credit = 0.67 semester credit
