1. Data Types

The following types of data will be generated and/or used in this project:

- Land conservation data (obtained from the Biodiversity Conservation Trust through a Data Sharing Agreement)
- Land values (accessible on the website of the Australian Bureau of Statistics)
- Quantitative survey of private landholders, residents and people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds.
- Interview data
- Government reports and other secondary data sources.

The data will be saved simultaneously on my password-protected university laptop, flash drive, student email and Western Sydney Onedrive.

2. Data Access and Intellectual Property

The collected data will only be stored by me. Access to the data will be shared by the student and the supervisory pane. Data provided or obtained on the condition of respecting the privacy of people will not be shared with any external sources.

4. Data Sharing and Reuse
