



Careers in Education Teacher Cadet Scholarship Application Criteria \$500

This scholarship is awarded to a student who has shown outstanding achievement in the Careers in Education program, both on the work site and in the lab, as well as in the classroom, and as an active member of our local chapter of Educators Rising.

The scholarship award will be based upon the following criteria:

- Graduating senior enrolled in the CTE Careers in Education program during senior year with a plan to pursue a career related to education/teaching.
- Have earned an A average grade in your CTE program.
- Preference will be given to students who have participated in Educators Rising Regional Competition, shown improvement in the CIE program throughout the year, and assisted other students in the program to improve skills.
- Your application and essay will be evaluated on class performance, attendance, attitude, involvement in school and community activities, and work experience.

How to Apply:

- Complete the CTE online application.
- Along with the application, submit **a one-page essay** that includes why you deserve this scholarship, your student competition experience, and your activities and accomplishments while you've been in the Careers in Education program.
- Submit the essay to the CTE Student Services office.

If you are awarded a scholarship, it is expected that you will be present at the spring Student Awards Ceremony where scholarships are presented. If selected for the scholarship, a thank you letter is required.
