

# Google Sites Skill Checklist

You will be learning your way around **Google Sites** today. This is the tool you will use to build a website to present at the ASLA Expo. To begin, open Google Drive and find the “**Sports Website files**” **folder** in “Shared with me”. Open the folder named “2023 Practice Sites”. Find the Google Sites Practice Site **with your name** and double-click. When it’s open, follow the instructions below and check off the skills below as you complete this activity.

## Part 1: Creating Content

Using the “Insert” menu at the top right of the screen. Practice the skills below on the page with your name on it.

- Add a text box
- Make a collapsable text box
- Change the color of the background for the text
- Change the size of the text box
- Make another text box and move it next to the old one
- Delete block of text using the “trash” icon
- Copy a text box using the “duplicate” icon
- Add a picture from the Web
- Move a picture in line with text
- Add a picture from Drive
- Crop the picture
- Add a caption to the picture
- Create an image carousel
- Add a dividing line
- Add a Google Drive document or slideshow
- Add a YouTube video
- Change the size of the YouTube video

## Part 2: Organizing Your Site

Click on the “Pages” menu at the top right of the screen. Using tools in the sidebar, practice the skills below.

- Make a new page
- Rename the page
- Make your new page a subpage of the page with your name on it by dragging it on top
- Make a new page and make it a subpage of your subpage
- Make a new subpage using the “Add a subpage” action from the menu
- Delete a page

## Part 3: Changing the Look

Click on the “Themes” menu at the top right of your screen. Using the tools in the sidebar, practice the skills below.

- Change the theme to the “Vision”
- Change to another theme
- Change the colors of your site
- Change the fonts
- Change the font style
- Change the look of the header on one of your pages
- Make a custom header by using a picture from the Web
- Make “buttons” that link to some of your other pages

## Part 4: Other Tools

See if you can find your way around the Google Sites tools available to do the following actions.

- Share your site with Mr. Brunkin
- Preview what your site will look like on a smartphone
- Change the title of your Site
- Change the title of a page
- Change the look of the navigation menus
- Edit one of your friend’s sites
