

## HUUSD: Timeline for K-6th Grade Intradistrict Choice Transitions

- Last updated 4/6/22

*If a family is considering Intradistrict Choice (IDC), but they have not yet applied or IDC has not yet been granted, school tours/ meetings with the principal or designee may be granted.*

Date/Event	Description
<p>APRIL</p> <p>Welcome from New School</p>	<p>Receiving schools send a letter of welcome, outlining the transition process, to new families/students.</p>
<p>MAY</p> <p>Information Exchange</p>	<p>New students &amp; family tour school, meet w/ principal or school counselor, if requested by the family.</p> <p><i>** We do not provide class visits/shadowing days, nor arrange for meetings with new teachers. (Just as students within the building do not have meetings with next year's teachers ahead of the school year.)</i></p> <p>Student information to support transition sought from sending school (see transition file cover <a href="#">sample form</a>)</p> <p>IEP (Individualized Education Plan) or 504 transition meetings held, for students with these plans.</p>
<p>JUNE</p> <p>Step up Day</p>	<p>Incoming students participate in school based Step-Up day, noting that step-up days look different in each school.</p>
<p>SUMMER</p> <p>Systems Exchange</p>	<p>School staff transfer technology accounts, powerschool registration, etc. to new school.</p>
<p>SEPTEMBER</p> <p>New student orientation</p>	<p>New student orientation is embedded into the start of the school year.</p>
