What is West Central ATL?

West Central ATL is a **two-year alternative licensure program** designed to help new teachers succeed in the classroom. You are the teacher of record and earn a teacher's salary with 360 wrap-around support. You'll work with an in-house mentor weekly. You will build an electronic portfolio to house your ATL assignments. Most work is done asynchronously with lots of guidance and feedback. Here is <u>an overview</u> of our program.

Basic Requirements:

- Full-time teaching position (at least 51% in licensure area). Some exceptions to full-time may apply.
- Statement of Eligibility (SOE) from the State, Praxis Test (or qualifying credits),
 Fingerprints
- ATL license ideally obtained before teaching begins

Coursework is required in reading based on your grade level and subject area.

Cost & Financial Assistance

Good News! 🎉



Teachers are covered for the bulk of the cost of the WCATL program via a grant from the State of Colorado. However, it is first-come, first-served, and no guarantee is given. The total cost of the program is \$10,950. The ERR grant may cover up to \$9950.

What You Will Need to Pay For:

- ATL <u>License Application</u> Fee: \$90 (CDE eligible for grant reimbursement)
- Praxis exam fees if necessary (each exam is \$130)
- Fingerprints: Approx. \$40
- Required Book: The Beginning Teacher's Field Guide by Tina Boogren (~\$30)
- Teacher buy-in: \$500 per year

Scholarship & Reimbursement Opportunities

CDE ERR Scholarship

• Covers nearly all program costs and is open to current teachers. The application window opens in July (Do NOT apply before then!) You must commit to teaching in a rural CDE-approved school for 3 years to avoid repayment

TEACH Colorado Reimbursement

- \$100 fee reimbursement available to cover license fees
- Must subscribe to TEACH Colorado before applying to CDE
