## Tools:

- 1) EFD Equipment on initial response vehicles
  - a) PFDs, rope throw bags, pike poles, ground ladders, hoselines, backboard.
- 2) East Tech Rescue Equipment on HASRT Truck
  - a) Mustang Ice Rescue Suits w/PFDs, Ice Picks, Rope Throw Bags, Ice Sled, Inflatable Boat, etc.

# Objectives:

- 1) EFD initial response tools and equipment review.
- 2) East Tech (Formerly HASRT) response tools and equipment review.
- 3) Reach, Throw (No row or go) with EFD initial response equipment.
- 4) Row and Go Rescue with East Tech equipment by EFD FF's or East Tech.
- 5) EFD rescue capabilities will not include any ice rescue in moving water unless training EFD members are on scene for rescue and backup.

\*\*\* Since We do not have ice we will meet at 1s and cover the tools and equipment and don the suits and cover tethering rescuers and the sled and boat. \*\*\* When we have ice, training officer will organize practical training.
